#### ELIGIBILITY

- Any individual, who is a member of the laity, that exemplifies the spirit and tradition of the late Pope, John XXIII.
- Individual can be of any religious denomination.

#### QUALIFICATIONS

- The applicant must demonstrate achievements in one of the following areas:
  - a) Community Betterment of Civic Endeavors
  - b) Ecumenical Spirit in furthering the Brotherhood of Man
  - c) Charitable and/or Religious Activities

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- The following supporting material must accompany each application:
  - a) Official Nomination Form
  - b) Biographical Sketch
  - c) Letters of Endorsement from Civic and/or Religious Leaders
- The screening committee may request additional information from the nominators or references for the judges consideration.
- The completed "Official Nomination Form" should be detached and used as the cover sheet for the nomination packet. All nominations and support material must be printed on paper no larger than 8 1/2" X 11". The entire nomination packet should be contained in a single folder.
- Decisions of the judges are final. All entries for the Pope John XXIII Award must be mailed to: **Italian Catholic Federation, 675 Hegenberger Road, Suite 110, Oakland, CA 94621**, no later than May 1.

The Award will be presented at the Italian Catholic Federation National Convention.
