> Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament

o Considered both a religious and civic landmark, the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament is one of the largest cathedrals west of the Mississippi River. Seat of Bishop Jaime Soto, it is the mother church of the diocese, which stretches from the southern edge of Sacramento County north to the Oregon border and serves approximately 1 million Catholics. The diocese encompasses 102 churches in a 42,000 square mile region.

> Our Lady of Guadalupe Museum

Behind Our Lady of Guadalupe Church and National Shrine in Sacramento is a museum found in only two other cities in the world: Rome and Jerusalem. Sacramento is home to a replica of the Shroud of Turin displayed at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center in Jerusalem; including 22 panels of scientific and historical information and a replica of the Shroud of Turin given by Cardinal Severino Poletto of Turin in northern Italy, a holographic display and a life-sized sculpture of Jesus Christ.
