In 2021, out of 113 active branches, we received 66 reports. Next year, I would love to see 100% of the branches sending in reports. All branches do apostolic and charitable activities, please submit a report, so we know about your activities. You should be proud of all the good work you do! The districts or areas with 100% participation for 2021 are: Central Coast, Contra Costa, Marin, and Reno. The complete report was in the October 2021 Bollettino.

As a whole, in 2021, the ICF donated **\$274,344.00**. While this is a decrease from the previous year, branches are to be commended for continuing their good works during this difficult time. We also donated \$41,000 to Cooley's Anemia Research which was presented at the 2021 Convention. Dr. Coates and Laurice Levine are much appreciative of our efforts.
