Please ask your Chaplain to send his Diocesan Letter of Good Standing to the I.C.F. Spiritual Director by August 1, 2025. The letter can be sent to Italian Catholic Federation, 8393 Capwell Drive, Suite 110, Oakland, CA 94621. Attn: Fr. Chris Bennett. Fr. Chris will then provide all of the letters to the Diocese of Fresno. Without the letter on file, the Chaplain may not concelebrate.

Please note that if your Chaplain is attending the Friday Night Dinner (\$65.00), the Saturday Night Banquet (\$70.00) or the Sunday Luncheon (\$45.00) your District/Branch will be responsible for the purchase of his ticket and he will be seated with your group. Only Diocesan Chaplains are covered by the I.C.F.

We look forward to seeing you and that we will once again experience a successful Convention.
