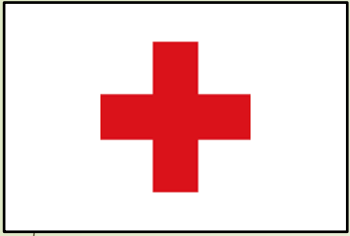

Hospitalization Plan

Financial support for ICF members when hospitalized or have surgery

Elegibility

- Any ICF member under 70
- New members over 70 may enroll at time of joining ICF

Important Notes

- Must stay overnight in acute care facility (or outpatient surgery)
- ER/Rehab/Convalescent not covered
- Membership continues beyond age 70

Benefits

- After 90 days:
 - \$75 for first day
 - \$50 for second day
 - \$25 for third day and beyond
- \$100 for surgery (inpatient or outpatient)
- Up to \$500/year
- \$500 max per illness

Scholarship Program

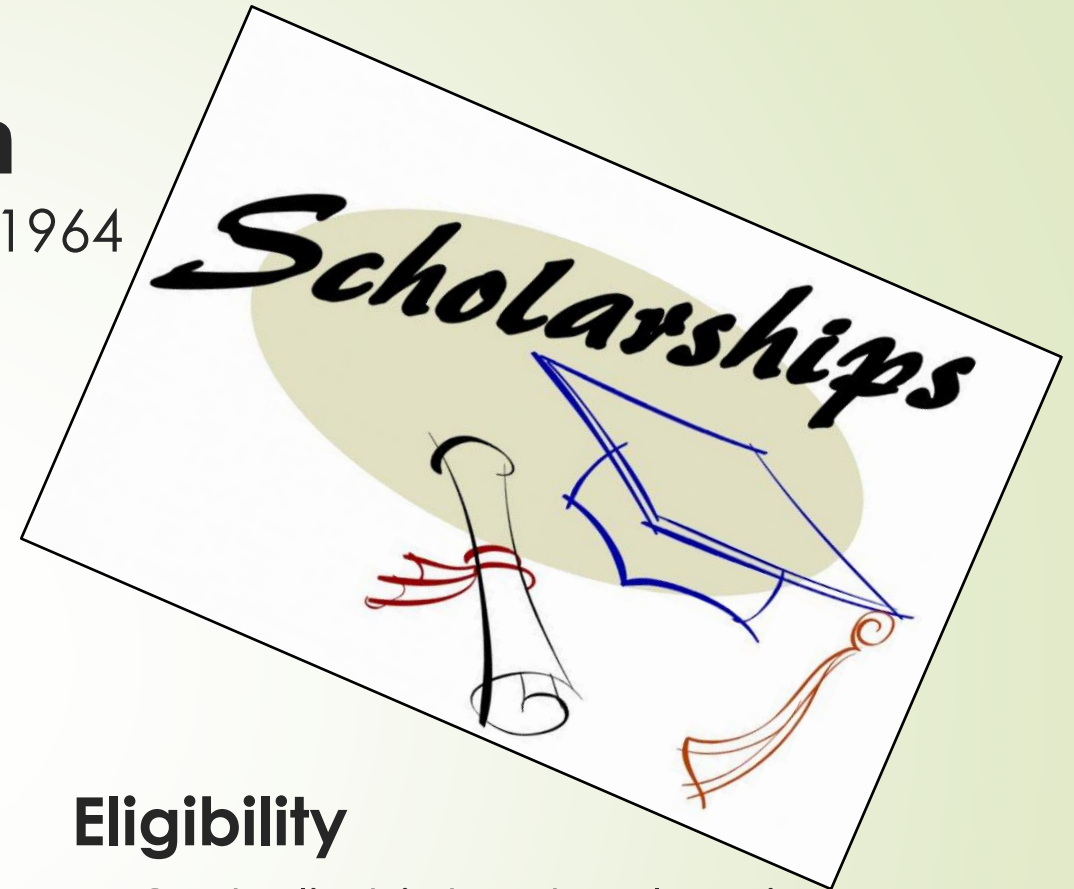
Investing in Catholic Youth since 1964

Impact

- Over \$2 million awarded
- More than 6,000 students supported

Award Amounts

- 1st year: \$400 (~150 recipients)
- 2nd year: \$500
- 3rd year: \$600
- 4th year: \$1000



Eligibility

- Catholic high school seniors planning to attend college
- Cumulative GPA 3.2+
- Applicants from public and private schools in CA, NV, & IL
- Application window every Spring

Providenza Fund

Encouraging religious vocation through financial aid

History

- Named for Sir Luigi and Lady Augusta Providenza

Supports

- Seminarians in CA, NV & IL
- Bishop's Day program



Gifts of Love

Financial support for disabled children and adults

Highlights

- Provides grants to disabled people seeking support for greater independence
- Focus on inclusion and empowerment

Impact

- Over \$750,000 Donated
- Fosters greater inclusion for people with disabilities



Live to Give:

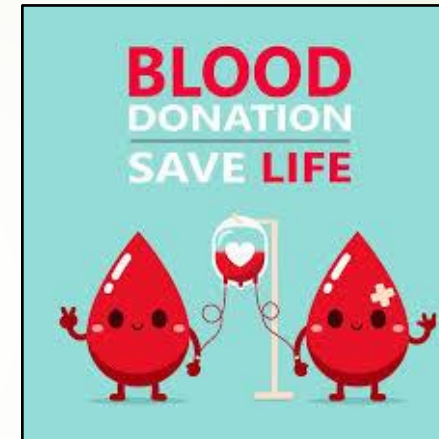
Promoting life-saving acts of generosity through blood and organ donation awareness

- Inspiring members to give the gift of life

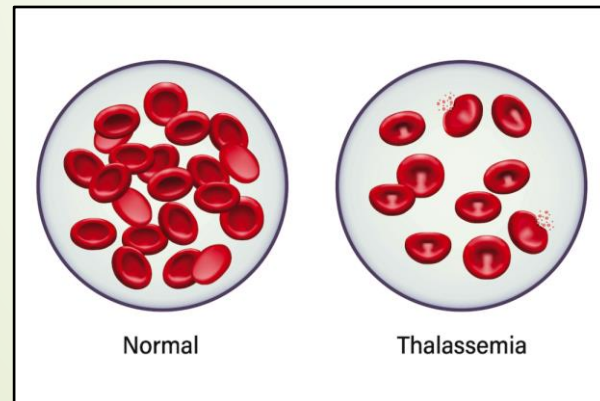


Cooley's Anemia: Our National Charity

Supporting quality of life and research for a cure

What is Cooley's Anemia?

- Severe form of Thalassemia, a genetic blood disorder
- Primarily impacts individuals of Mediterranean descent
- Currently requires frequent blood transfusions

- Over \$2 million in donations to date
